THE WEST CENTRAL RELIABILITY PROJECT

The proposed West Central Reliability Project is a new 138kV electric transmission line to be constructed on steel poles between ComEd's existing substations near the communities of Bartlett and Itasca. The new line will connect these substations and extend across portions of DuPage and Cook counties primarily with the Elgin – O'Hare Expressway corridor.
