**VILLAGE OF ROSELLE
DECLARATION OF LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY
MARCH 20, 2020**

State of Illinois
Counties of DuPage and Cook
Village of Roselle

Pursuant to the authority vested in the office of the Mayor by the Illinois Municipal Code Section 5/11-1-6, the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act Section 330/5/11, and Chapter 2, Article XIX of the Village Code, the undersigned Mayor of the Village of Roselle hereby declares that a Local State of Emergency exists as of this date March 20, 2020, and shall continue until such time as provided in Chapter 2, Article XIX of the Village Code. As Mayor, having been duly sworn, I hereby aver that the following recitations constitute the basis for this declaration.

In late 2019, a new and significant outbreak of Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID – 19) emerged. COVID – 19 is a novel severe acute respiratory illness that can spread among people through respiratory transmissions. Despite efforts to contain COVID – 19, the World Health Organization (WHO) and Centers for Disease Control (CDC) indicate that it is expected to spread; and

As a result of the potential impact of the COVID – 19 outbreak on the State of Illinois, Illinois Governor Pritzker declared all counties of the State of Illinois as a disaster area on March 9, 2020 and activated the State of Emergency Operations Center; and

On March 11, 2020 the WHO characterized the COVID - 19 outbreak as a public health emergency of international concern and declared a worldwide pandemic; and

On March 13, 2020, President Trump declared the COVID – 19 pandemic of sufficient severity and magnitude to warrant an emergency declaration for all states, tribes, territories, and the District of Columbia; and

Competent epidemiologists recommend that local authorities participate in strategies directed at reducing the potential impact of COVID – 19; and

Based on the declared pandemic by the WHO and the declarations of public emergency by the federal government and State of Illinois, I hereby find that it is necessary that the Village of Roselle undertake lawful, necessary, and


appropriate actions to protect the public's health in response to the COVID – 19 outbreak.

During the existence of the Local State of Emergency, I shall execute such authority as provided under the Illinois Municipal Code, the Illinois Emergency Management Act, and Chapter 2, Article XIX of the Village Code and am hereby authorized to:

Take any and all actions that are necessary and appropriate to carry out the mission of the Village and protect the health, safety, and wellbeing of all Village employees and the community including, but not limited to, (a) the procurement of, and payment for, services, supplies, equipment, or material without regard to statutory procedures or formalities normally prescribed by law pertaining to Village contracts or obligations (b) manage and direct Village employees in a manner that effectively provides municipal services to resident and business owners in the community, and (c) undertake any additional actions authorized by State Statute, Chapter 2 Article XIX of the Village Code, and Governor Pritzker's Executive Order 2020 – 07.

During the pendency of this Declaration of Local State of Emergency, I hereby rescind the Cancellation of the Village Board meeting scheduled for April 13, 2020 and schedule a Village Board meeting for that date to determine whether this Declaration should be extended and to conduct any other business I deem necessary as described in Executive Order 2020 – 07. An agenda of that meeting shall be electronically published on the Village's website no later than 72 hours prior to the meeting. The notice shall include items for the agenda as well as the manner in which the meeting shall be conducted.

I have signed this Declaration willingly, and executed it as my free and voluntary act for the purposes therein expressed.
