



**2022 STREET CONSTRUCTION
PAVING WORK
Bulletin No. 2
August 29, 2022**

Our contractor has completed all the intermittent curb, sidewalk removal & replacement, underground utility work, street grinding, and patching on your street.

Weather permitting; our paving contractor will begin paving work August 30th or August 31st. Early in the morning prior to paving the contractor will apply an oily tar-like material (prime coat) on the street to help bond the old pavement to the new asphalt. This process is accomplished before a layer of hot-mix asphalt is laid. "Fresh Oil" signs will be posted. If you must drive on it, DRIVE VERY SLOWLY. Then the first layer, called "leveling binder" is placed to smooth the irregularities in our streets. After the placement of the leveling binder, final surface installation will follow. During this phase of the construction, the roads will remain open to vehicular traffic and driveway access will be maintained.
